PLAGIARISM is the presentation by a student of an assignment or piece of work which has in fact been copied in whole or in part from another student's work, or from any other source (e.g. published books or periodicals or material from Internet sites), without due acknowledgement in the text.

TEAMWORK: It is the goal of all subjects in the Department of Mathematics and Statistics to develop generic skills that will be useful in the workplace in addition to developing specific skills, knowledge and understanding in Mathematics and Statistics. A key generic skill is teamwork. Students are encouraged to work with each other (both inside and outside practice classes) to develop their technical skills and to increase their knowledge and understanding of the curriculum, in part because this develops the capacity for teamwork.

In the case of marked assignments or other non-examination assessments in the Department of Mathematics and Statistics, such teamwork includes general discussion and sharing of ideas on the work. All written work must however (without specific authorisation to the contrary) be done by individual students. Students are neither permitted to copy any part of another student's work nor permitted to allow their own work to be copied by other students.
